You need the following:

- A Student ID with a valid library barcode
- Internet Access

1. Go to the library's web page
<http://library.stcc.edu>

2. Under the word "Databases" on the left side of the page,
select either "By Subject" or "By Title".

3. Scroll down to the Database you wish to use, and click on "Off Cam-
pus".

4. Type your 14 DIGIT BARCODE (without spaces) from the back
of your library card (in box that says to enter your Library card #) and
enter your LAST NAME in other box.

5. Click "Submit Query".
